### RED WINE

Organic Wine  
750ml

Estate-bottled: 17 and 18 June, 2015  
Alcohol: 14.5% alc/vol  
Residual sugar: 0.23 g/l  
Acidity: 2.80 g/l

### TERROIR

Soil: Sandy, clay with limestone  
Land: South and East-West terraces

### VITICULTURE & HARVEST

Grape varieties: Cabernet Franc (60%), Merlot (40%)  
Harvest: Hand harvest - Selection Parcelaire  
Plantation density: 8000 vines per ha  
Age of vines: 8 years old  
Yield: 30 hl/ha

### WINEMAKING

De-stemming  
Alcoholic fermentation small concrete vats  
Temperature control  
Gentle pumping of the cap

### AGEING

12 months in small concrete vats (80%) and French oak barrels (20%)

### TASTING NOTES

Deep purple colour. Opening aromas of herbs, cranberry, cherry and cinnamon, which translate to the palate with added notes of spice, leather and tobacco. Bold, opulent and delicious.
