WINEMAKING

De-stemming

Alcoholic fermentation in small temperature-controlled concrete vats.

Gentle pumping of the cap

AGEING

Aged in barriques and demi-muids for 12 months

TASTING NOTES

With its dense purple colour, this cuvée expresses remarkable aromas of menthol, black cherry and blackberry, with nuances of mocha and caramel. Opulent and structured, the resulting body is expressive and refined, beautifully enhanced by sensual tannins. This wine has panache and a big personality.
