



Domaine Sainte Cécile du Parc
Pézenas Sonatina 2013 *

In the 17th Century, the Duc de Montmorency used to hunt on this land when he stayed over in Pézenas, which was then the capital of the Languedoc State. Acquired by Christine Mouton Bertoli in 2005, the terraced vineyards (15 ha of which 10 in production), were converted to organic farming and encircle the new winery which has been running since 2011. All the wines carry musical names in reference to Saint Cecilia, the patron of music.

The colour is dense, the aromas powerful and varied, promising mature fruit, liquorice, spices and wild herbs. In the mouth the wine is complex, generous, intense, full-bodied, dominated by the spices and toasted flavours of the barriques et enhanced by balanced tannins. Good potential for this inherently Mediterranean wine
